Whereas, the Environmental Advisory Council also understands the importance of City planning staff in the implementation of the Comprehensive Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Reading Environmental Advisory Council encourages Reading City Council to hire an urban planner dedicated solely to the implementation of the Comprehensive Plan and other visionary plans for the City. This would be in addition to the hiring of other City staff dedicated to the administration of the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance and to other planning duties.
