

EACs are officially constituted municipal boards created to advise local governments on environmental issues and policies.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Identifying environmental problems and recommending remedies
- Inventorying open spaces and natural features and recommending best uses and management practices
- Formulating and promoting programs for the promotion and conservation of natural resources and environmental quality
- Identifying funding sources to protect and study natural resources and environmental quality and develop proposals to obtain funding
- Recommending uses of open space and advising Council on acquisition of additional open space
- Commenting on applications for subdivision, variance or conditional use when requested to do so by Council or the Planning Commission
- Helping homeowners and other residents understand the impact of their decisions on the environment and the larger community




