### MATCHING FUNDS

- Most Projects Require 50/50 Match (\$1 for \$1)
- Secured Matching Funds With Letters Of Commitment
- Match Is Not Eligible If Spent Before Grant Agreement Period

#### **CASH**

- MOST Federal Funds
- SOME State Funds
- MOST Local Funds
- MOST Private Funds

#### **NON-CASH**

- In-House Labor
- Equipment Use
- Donations (Goods & Services)
- Volunteers

Assists Applicants In Creating An Implementable Plan With Strong Public Input To Guide Future Investments



- Indoor Recreation Facility Feasibility Study



# Grants ACQUISITION

- Assists Applicant In Securing Land To Be Used As:
  - Critical Habitat Areas And/Or Natural Areas
  - Park And Recreation Areas
  - Greenways And Open Space
- Land Can Be Secured Through Fee Acquisition Or Permanent Easements

Three Different Trail Opportunities

- Motorized
- Non-motorized
- ATV & Snowmobile

Project Types Include:

- Planning
- Acquisition
- Development
- Equipment Purchase
- Educational Programs

ATV & Snowmobile Trail Projects Have Two Grant Rounds Per Year – Spring & Fall



### DEVELOPMENT

### Park Rehabilitation & New Development

- Assists Applicants With Rehabilitation and New Development Projects, Such As:
  - Playgrounds
  - Skate Parks
  - Sport Fields/Courts/Rinks
  - Swimming Pools & Splash Pads
  - Pavilions & Comfort Stations
  - Indoor Recreational Facilities
- Average Grant Requests Range From \$100,000 - \$250,000





### DEVELOPMENT

### **Small Community Program**



Assists Municipalities With A Population Of 5,000 Or Less With Basic Rehabilitation And New Development Project Such As:

- Playgrounds
- Pavilions
- Accessibility Upgrades
- Grants Require Smaller Match Commitment
- Grant Request Minimum Is \$50,000
- Grant Request Maximum Is \$70,000
- Total Project Cannot Exceed \$110,000
  - \$10,000 Is Earmarked For Professional Services Fees And Requires No Match
  - \$20,000 Is Earmarked For Materials/Equipment And Requires No Match





### RIPARIAN FOREST BUFFERS



Grants To Install Riparian Forest Buffers Along Waterways. Eligible Project Costs Include:

- Landowner Outreach
- Buffer Design
- Site Preparation & Buffer Installation
- Plant Materials & Tree Shelters
- Post-planting Establishment (Approximately 3 Years)






# Other Funding Sources

- 1. Riparian Buffer Mini Grants DCNR Grant made to PA Association of Conservation Districts for mini grants to county conservation district for "smaller (>\$50K)" riparian buffer projects. Contact your Watershed Specialist at your county conservation district for more information. 50/50 match.
- 2. Department of Community and Economic Development Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program (GTRP) for planning, acquisition, development, rehabilitation and repair of greenways, trails, recreational areas, open space and parks <a href="https://dced.pa.gov/programs/greenways-trails-and-recreation-program-gtrp/">https://dced.pa.gov/programs/greenways-trails-and-recreation-program-gtrp/</a> \$250 K limit, 15% match required.
- **3. PA Conservation Landscapes** Mini Grant Program Projects and requirements similar to C2P2 funding for smaller projects. Range \$1000 \$25,000K requests. 50/50 match. Cannot match C2P2 funding.
